

ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1 Chapter 2-92 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended adding a new section, 2-92-587 as follows:

2-92-587 Immigration Enforcement Disclosure.

This section shall be known and cited as the "Immigration Enforcement Disclosure Ordinance". The purpose of this section is to promote full and accurate disclosure to the public about any companies who have worked with or profited from immigration enforcement contracting, immigration enforcement services, or any other activity related to federal immigration enforcement within the U.S.A. who are doing business with the City.

Each contractor with whom the City enters into a contract, whether subject to competitive bid or not, must complete an affidavit verifying all past or present contracts, services, or activities related to immigration enforcement with U.S. Customs and Border Protection, U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement, or any related or subsequent agency that enforces immigration laws, delivered by the contractor. The basic details of any contracts, including the dollar amount contracted and the term of the contract, must be disclosed in the affidavit. The chief procurement officer shall make the information available to the public in an easily accessible format and provide an annual report to the city council.

Failure to comply with this section shall deem the contract voidable on behalf of the City.

SECTION 2 This ordinance shall be effective upon approval.
