Call for hearing(s) on Chicago's Cycling

Strategy for plans to create community-cased

cycling system

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, In March of 2023 the Chicago Department of Transportation (CDOT) released the Chicago Cycling Strategy, outlining a community-driven approach to expanding Chicago's bike network and creating a more equitable, safe, and inviting city for cycling; and

WHEREAS, The Chicago Cycling Strategy aims to work on the citywide and neighborhood scales, allowing for flexible approaches to best meet the needs of residents and reflect the rapidly evolving nature of our transportation system; and

WHEREAS, Chicago's bike network has grown an average of 30 miles per year since 2020; and

WHEREAS, CDOT plans to implement 150 new miles of bikeways over the next few years; and

WHEREAS, This year People for Bikes ranked Chicago near the bottom of their list for bike-friendly big cities in the US due to the city's default 30 mph speed limit and lack of a connected low-stress bike network; and

WHEREAS, there have been five fatal cyclist crashes in Chicago so far in 2023; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, In October of 2023 the Chicagoland area saw a streak of three deaths over the span of three weeks due to cycling-related accidents; and

WHEREAS, Chicago's bike network has grown an average of 30 miles per year since 2020; and

WHEREAS, CDOT's vision is to build an equitable transportation system that provides people with mobility options and is focused on keeping our most vulnerable users of the street safe; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, That we, the members of the City Council for the City of Chicago, do hereby call upon the Committee on Pedestrian and Traffic Safety to hold a subject matter hearing on Chicago's Cycling Strategy to gain a deeper understanding of CDOT's plans to create a community-based cycling system in Chicago that prioritizes bicyclist safety.
