**Title:** Amendment of Municipal Code Section 2-173-042 allowing agents or agencies of Chicago to work with federal immigration officers in specified circumstances

**ORDINANCE**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:**

**SECTION 1.** Chapter 2-173 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by deleting the language struck through and by inserting the language underscored, as follows:


**2-173-042 Reserved Unprotected Activities for Federal Immigration Enforcement Actions.**

Any agent or agency of the City of Chicago shall be allowed to work with federal immigration officers or agencies only when an individual granted protections by this ordinance:

- (1) has been arrested for any of the following:
  - (A) gang-related activities included but not limited to loitering, intimidation, recruitment;
  - (B) drug-related activities included but not limited to the purchasing, selling, distribution of any substance considered to be an illegal drug by the Food and Drug Administration;
  - (C) prostitution-related activities included but not limited to solicitation, performance, human trafficking of adults;
  - (D) sexual crimes involving minors;
- (2) has been convicted of a felony in any court of competent jurisdiction for any of the following:
  - (A) gang-related activities included but not limited to loitering, intimidation, recruitment;
  - (B) drug-related activities included but not limited to the purchasing, selling, distribution of any substance considered to be an illegal drug by the Food and Drug Administration;
  - (C) prostitution-related activities included but not limited to solicitation, performance, human trafficking of adults;
  - (D) sexual crimes involving minors;

**SECTION 2.** This ordinance shall take effect immediately following passage and publication, applying retroactively beginning on August 31, 2022.
